The workshop is hosted during the margins of the "European Union (EU) Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Southern Africa Business Climate Survey " to be held on 20 February 2017.

Background of H2020

Horizon 2020 is the European Union's (EU) Framework Programme for research and innovation stems from the combination of "Europe2020" and the "Innovation Union" and is a successor to the 7th Framework Programme, providing investment support on research and innovation. Horizon 2020 is the biggest EU Research and Innovation Programme ever with €80 billion of funding available over 7 years (2014 to 2020).
