are aimed at students who study in their home country or in the country for which they have a residence permit.

„In-Region Scholarship“



are aimed at students who want to participate in a study programme in a country of their home region

- **Monthly living stipend**, varies – MA/PhD, in-country/in-region, country
- Once-off yearly **study and research allowance**
 - 460 EUR for MA / 920 EUR for PhD
- **Tuition fees** for the duration of study
- **Printing costs** at the end of study
 - 400 EUR for MA / 800 EUR for PhD
- For In-Region: **Travel allowance** and **health insurance**
- **Total investment MA: 15 000 – 20 000 EUR**
- **Total investment PhD: 30 000 – 45 000 EUR**

- Offer **training and support** for future decision makers in research, economy and administration in Sub-Saharan Africa
- Mark sustainable, **internationally competitive centres**
- Build upon **existing collaborations** between African and German universities

Centres of African Excellence: Instruments

- **Scholarships** for Bachelor, Masters and PhD Programs
- **Mobility Funds** for students, staff, lecturers and researchers
- Short and long term **visiting faculty** (African / German)
- **Short-term programmes**, such as Summer Schools
- **Capacity Building** trainings for teaching staff and supervisors
- **Annual Networking Meetings** (staff) and **Research Fair** (faculty) by/between Centres of African Excellence
- **E-learning platform DIGI-FACE** for blended learning activities, incl. soft skills training for students and staff; publication database
- **Alumni Network**

- **Funding period:** 1st phase = 2021 to 2025; 2nd phase = 2026 to 2030

- Climate Centres:
 - India/Thailand
 - Colombia/**South Africa**
 - Ivory Cost/Kenia
 - Jordan/Palestine/Israel

- Objectives: Implement outward-looking higher education institutions and build high-quality education systems targeting the Sustainable Development Goals
- Funding period: 2021 – 2025 (5 years)
