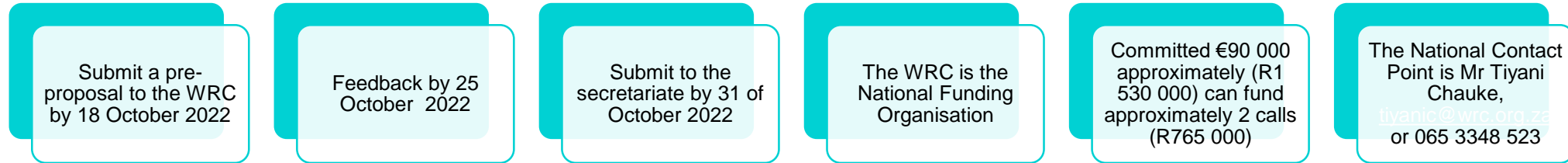
WATER4ALL 1ST JOINT TRANSNATIONAL CALL
