The SA – EU Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) opportunities are afforded through the various programmes funded under the Framework Programme (FP) for Research and Innovation (R&I), Horizon Europe. The SA-EU STI opportunities include programmes such as the Cooperation on Science and Technology (COST) and Marie Sklowdoska-Currie Actions (MSCA) which focus on researcher mobility. The session will include informative presentation on current opportunities, vibrant panel discussions with emerging researchers and information sharing on support instruments available for South African participants.

Research mobility is often overlooked particularly for early career-scientists and their access to centers of excellence in their respective areas of research. Scientists and innovators are becoming more aware of the importance of conducting research that seeks to address societal challenges. Researcher mobility programmes are mechanisms that facilitate the creation of innovative networks and encourage sharing of knowledge and best practice.
